

ECHA UPDATE NOTIFICATION DATA ON SVHCS IN ARTICLES

In November 11, 2014, ECHA updated data on SVHC candidate list substances in articles. This data provides examples of articles containing SVHCs that are included in the Candidate List. The data is based both on the notifications that companies have submitted to ECHA as well as on the information contained in the registration dossiers. ECHA will update the data every six months.



Notification Data

The data is based on notifications and registrations received before 23 September 2014 for substances that were included in the Candidate List on 16 December 2013 and earlier. That is 328 notifications for 36 SVHC candidates. The six most frequently notified substances are listed in the table below.

Notification Obligation

Producers and importers of articles containing any of the substances included in the Candidate List shall notify ECHA if both of the following conditions apply:

- the substance is present in those articles in quantities totalling over one tonne per producer or exporter per year, and
- the substance is present in those articles above a concentration of 0.1% weight by weight.

CTI Suggestion

It is possible that there were other articles containing Candidate List substances than those mentioned in the data. Furthermore, also other Candidate List substances other than those so far notified may be present in articles on the EU market. Companies are advised to conduct supply chain survey and fulfill the notification obligation if meeting the conditions.
